► CRITERIA FOR REGISTRATION

- Documented evidence of experience in project management: Self Assessment; Level B additionally: Report Proposal
- Experience required for each level:
Junior Project Manager: experience in project management (as project team member, pm-assistant, pm-coach, etc) is helpful but not required

Project Manager: at least 540 people days (PD; 1 year is 180 PD) experience in project management, including at least 360 people days experience as sole responsible project manager in minor complex projects.

Senior Project Manager: at least 900 people days experience in project management, including at least 540 people days experience as sole responsible project manager in complex projects

Project Management Executive: valid certification as Senior Project Manager; experience as programme manager, PM office manager or project portfolio manager for the last three years at least; publications and presentations in project management

► EDUCATION

4 – 6 days of Project Management education

► CRITERIA FOR REGISTRATION

CAPM®:

To apply for the CAPM, applicants need to have:

- a secondary diploma (high school or the global equivalent)
- and at least 1.500 hours experience or 23 hours of project management education.

PMP®:

To apply for the PMP, applicants need to have either:

- a four-year degree (bachelor's or the global equivalent) and at least three years of project management experience, with 4.500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education
- or a secondary diploma (high school or the global equivalent) with at least five years of project management experience, with 7.500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.

► EXAM

CAPM®:

- multiple choice test: 150 questions, 3 hours

PMP®:

- multiple choice test: 200 questions, 4 hours

The exam can be taken in English or 7 other languages (including German)

► RE-CERTIFICATION

CAPM®:

- multiple choice test after 5 years

PMP®:

- 60 Professional Development Units (PDUs) within 3 years
